Tutankhamun and the Valley of the Kings

With the *Tutankhamun and the Golden Age of the Pharaohs* exhibition drawing crowds in London, our 2008 day conference will be on the subject of Tutankhamun and the Valley of the Kings, looking at some of the tombs and other discoveries there. The lectures will put the archaeological discoveries in their historical and cultural context.

Our speakers will be Victor Blunden, Bob Partridge and Joyce Tyldesley.

The day will be divided into four sessions, with each lecturer giving one main lecture and also a shorter mini-lecture. There will be time for questions and discussions. The subjects covered will be:-

- Victor Blunden:** Tomb Decoration and Development in the Valley of the Kings and Highlights from the Tomb of Tutankhamun.
- Bob Partridge:** Discoveries in the Valley of the Kings before Tutankhamun and The Royal Valley today.
- Joyce Tyldesley:** Tutankhamun's family and Tomb 55 in the Royal Valley and The Discovery of Tutankhamun:
